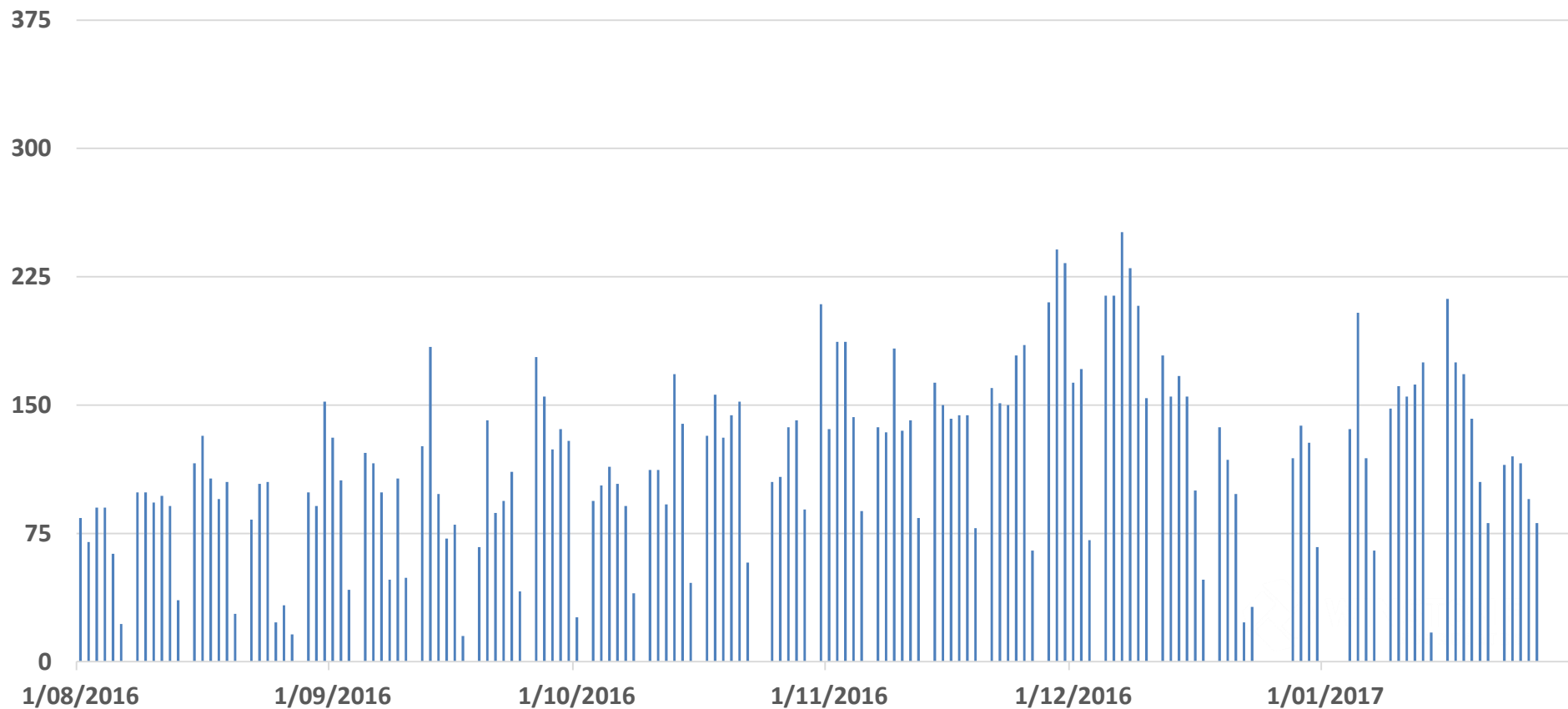

Daily Truck Movements

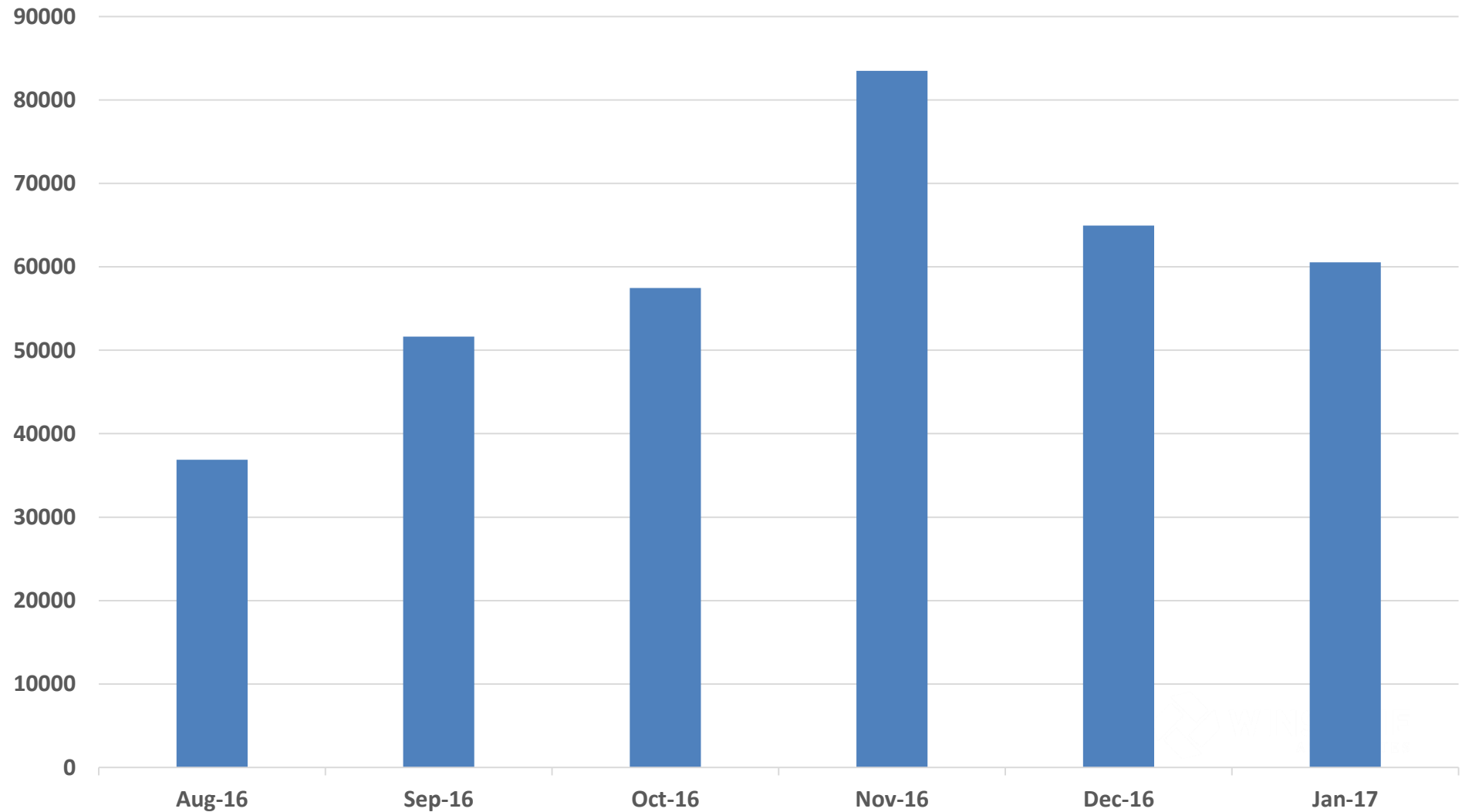
- The total number of trucks to enter site has been below the consented limit of 375

Incidents / Complaints Review

DATE:

22/11/2016

SUMMARY OF ISSUE:

Complaint received from a member of the public regarding congestion on Mt Eden Road and Kingsway as a result of workers and contractors parking along side of the road.

SUMMARY OF ACTION:

All staff and contractors associated with the Quarry park onsite at all times. Fletcher Living (SHA site) were informed of the complaint. Due to limited space at the SHA, not all workers and contractors can park onsite. The problem with road congestion is exacerbated due to road closure which is currently in place.

Incidents / Complaints Review

DATE:

25/11/2016

SUMMARY OF ISSUE:

Member of the public made a complaint regarding a near-miss incident at the Mt Albert Rd/Mt Eden Rd intersection involving a truck and pedestrians.

SUMMARY OF ACTION:

The driver was made aware of the complaint when he entered site. Trucking company was informed via phone & email of the incident and driver/truck details.

DATE:

23/12/2016

SUMMARY OF ISSUE:

Member of the public witnessed Gleeson & Cox trucks using St Andrews Road.

SUMMARY OF ACTION:

Gleeson & Cox drivers were reminded by staff on their next visit to site that St Andrews Road is not to be used. Gleeson & Cox Transport were contacted and informed of the complaint.

Incidents / Complaints Review

DATE:

18/01/2017

SUMMARY OF ISSUE:

A member of the public made a complaint to Auckland Council regarding the level of noise and heavy traffic on Mt Eden Road from trucks heading to Three Kings Quarry or the construction site on the corner of Mt Eden & Mt Albert Road.

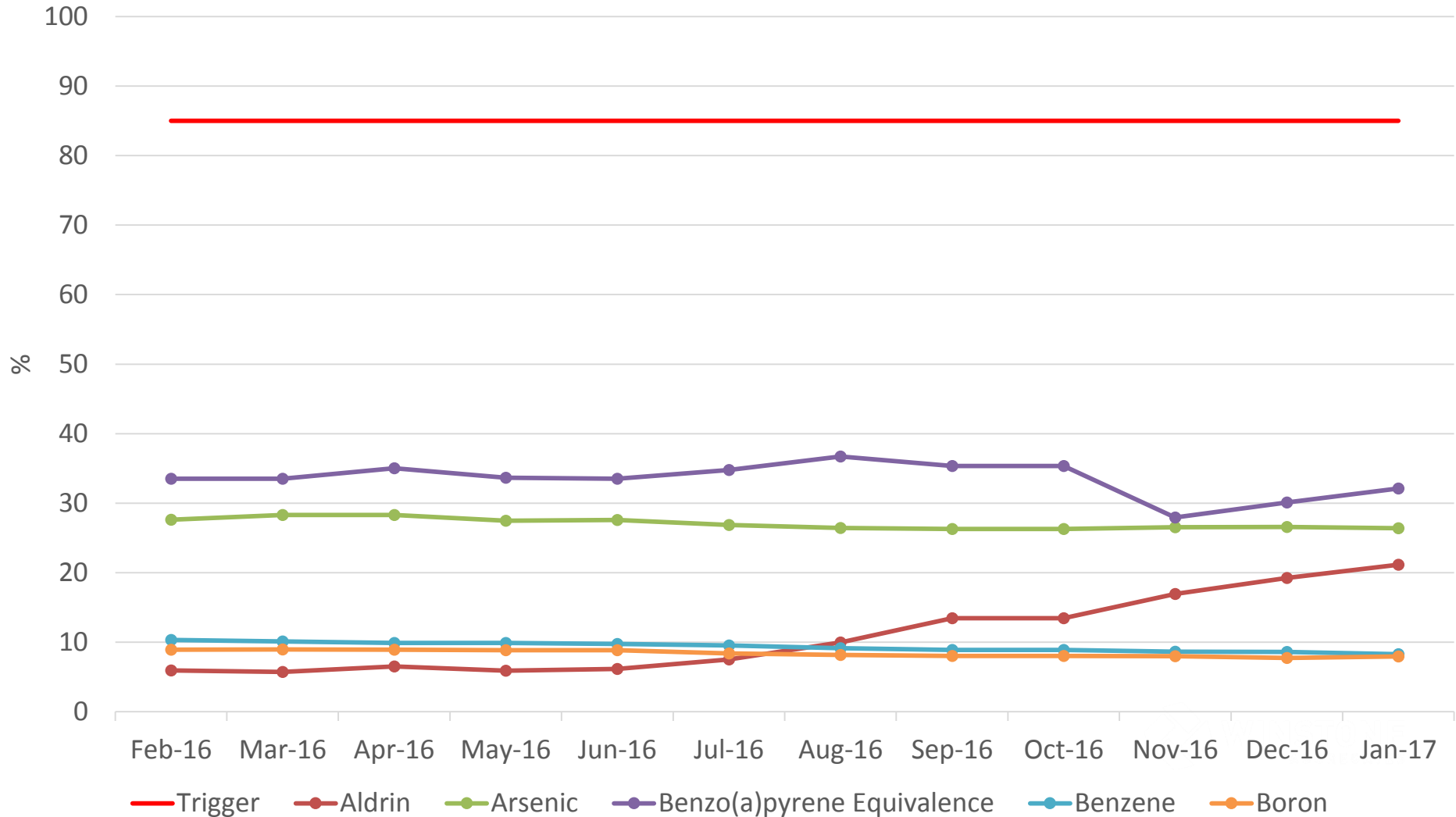
SUMMARY OF ACTION:

Mt Eden Road is the designated road to be used as per the approved Traffic Management Plan. The average number of trucks entering Three Kings Quarry was 134 per day in December 2016 and 122 per day in January 2017, which is well below the maximum consented limit of 375.

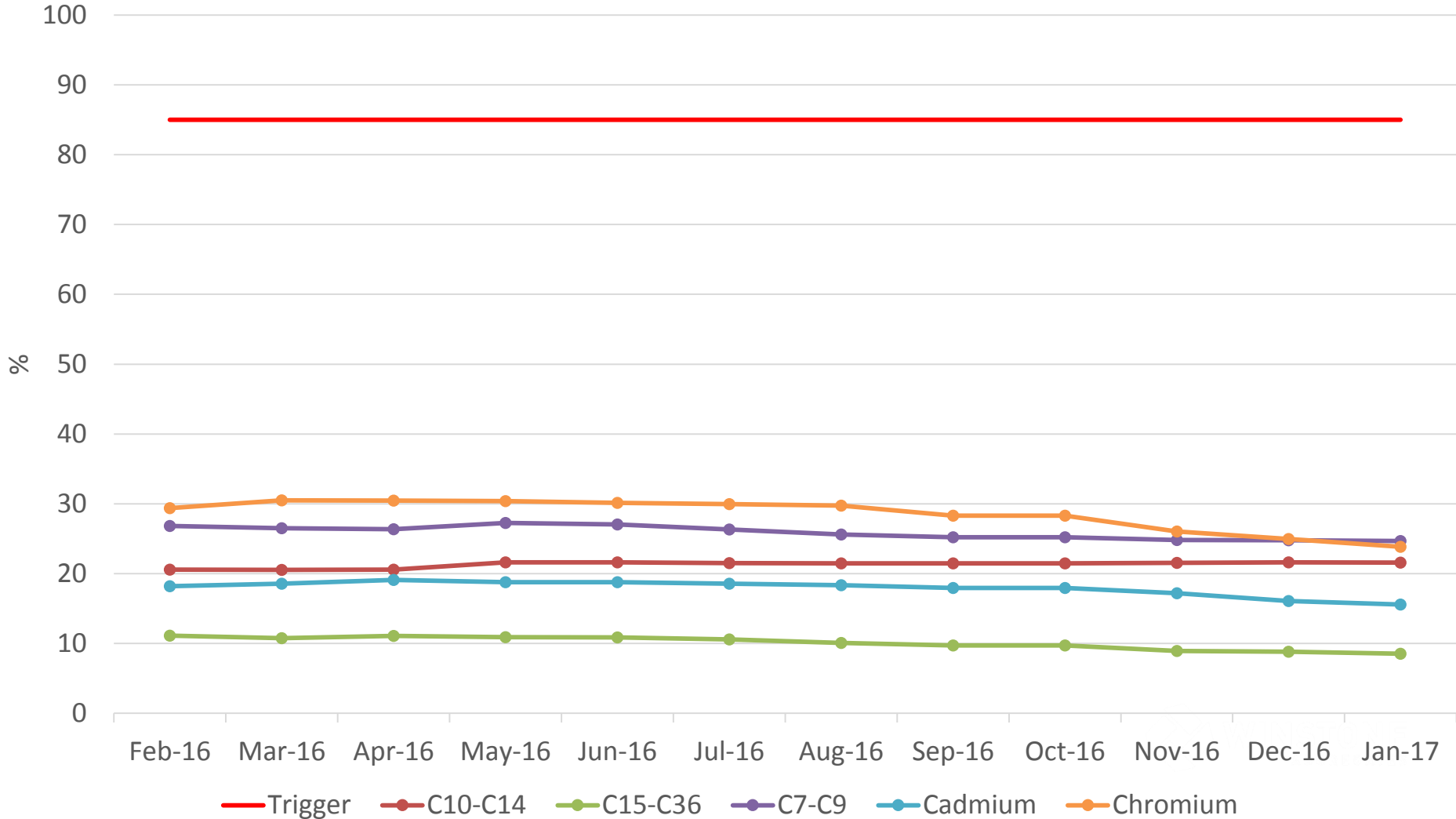
% Result of Weighted Criteria

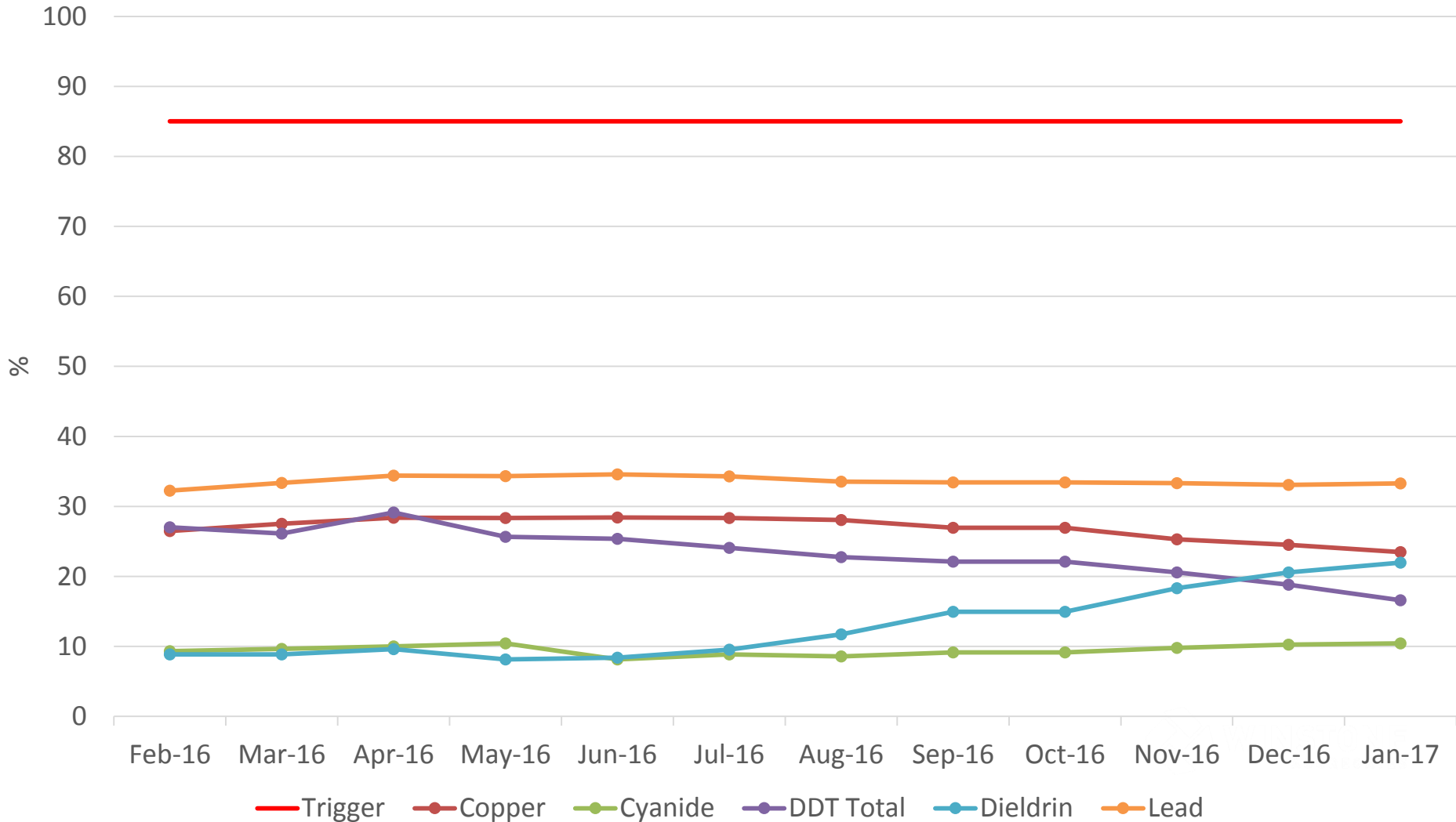

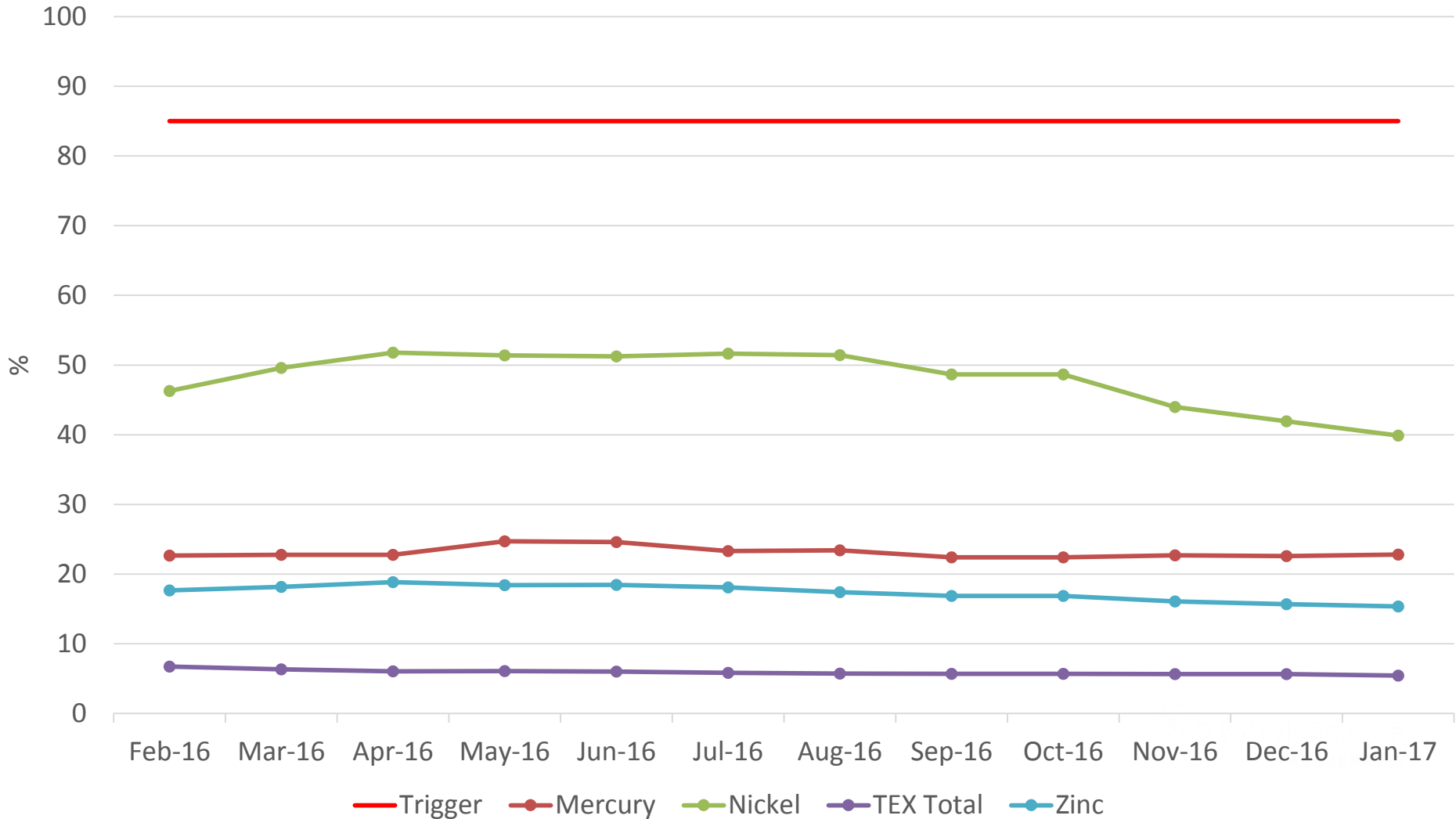
